



Alabama Agriculture Stabilization Program Cattle Producer Eligibility

Before proceeding through the application, please verify that you are eligible. In order to be eligible for this program, you must meet the following criteria, provide the required documentation, and successfully submit the application for review.

Application Period Opens September 8th at 9:00 am and ends on October 9th.

Please apply at: crf.alabama.gov or agi.alabama.gov and follow links to the Cattle Application.

- 1. You must be an Alabama resident.**
- 2. You must be able to provide documentation that you sold cattle during the date range of April 16, 2020 through May 15, 2020. Slaughter cattle and bulls do not qualify for payment.**
- 3. If claiming payment for Dairy Production, you must have been eligible for USDA's CFAP program for Dairy Production and you must provide the total amount of the CFAP payment you received for Dairy Production.**
- 4. ADAI will require each applicant to submit the following to qualify for eligibility:**
 - Copy of W-9**

- Successful submission of this application and signed certification and assurances form
- Bank account information for electronic payment
- Copy of a voided check or a memo from your bank with account number and routing number.

Maximum “per head” payments for beef cattle: No Payments for slaughter cattle or bulls:

Less than 600 lbs. x \$69/head

600-900 lbs. x \$106/head

Fed cattle (Fats) (over 900 lbs.) x \$181/head

Dairy Payment Information:

Alabama resident dairy producers would be eligible for a payment in addition to their CFAP payment in an amount not to exceed the CFAP payment they received from USDA. The exact percentage to be used for the state payment will be determined after all beef cattle payments have been processed and all dairy cattle applications have been received.
