

Poultry Entry Requirements

- All poultry coming into Alabama must be tested negative for Salmonella pullorum/typhoid (P/T) and Avian Influenza (AI) within 21 days prior to entry, or
- Originate from a flock that is participating in the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP), Salmonella P/T and AI clean programs.
- Hatching eggs and day old chicks must originate from flocks participating in the NPIP Salmonella P/T and AI clean programs or from flocks that have tested negative for Salmonella P/T and AI with 21 days prior to entry.
- Poultry from flocks participating in the NPIP programs may move using the NPIP Form 9-2 or 9-3.
- Non-NPIP poultry coming into Alabama must be accompanied with a Health Certificate written by an accredited veterinarian with results of the Salmonella P/T and AI tests, including date of test on the Health Certificate.
- Transport boxes, crates or carriers must be clean and allow for proper care of the birds in transport.
