### SPARKS' REMARKS

Commissioner  
Ron Sparks

For many years, rural Alabama depended upon low-skill, low-wage jobs to keep its economy going. However, in recent years these jobs have increasingly gone offshore and left many communities struggling to cope.

The downturn we now have in the economy hits rural areas worst. As a native of Dekalb County, I have seen the hosiery industry virtually disappear. In two years, Ft. Payne has lost hundreds of hosiery jobs.

Today 29 of our rural counties have double-digit unemployment. It is obvious that we've never really had a

rural economic/community development policy in Alabama.

We must rethink how we help rural communities survive. The 2007 census shows the numbers of farms in Alabama increasing as compared to the 2002 census. These are smaller farms trying to fill a "niche" in providing produce and livestock to nearby markets. We need to double our efforts to assist them.

Agriculture and tourism are two of Alabama's largest industries. Agriculture has been the traditional backbone of the state's economy and had more than \$9 billion impact last year.

## DEPARTMENT SCORES IN HUGE DRAGNET

Commissioner of Agriculture & Industries Ron Sparks recently held a press conference on a months-long sting operation that has led to a tremendous recovery of stolen property. Fifteen counties in Alabama and one in Florida are part of the dragnet. The total value of recovered items so far is more than half a million dollars and includes: cattle, tractors, backhoes, ATVs, power tools, utility and stock trailers. The investigation also led to the discovery of

other illegal items including drugs, moonshine, and untaxed liquor.

"The last six months have been exceptional for our investigations team," said Sparks. "Not only are they solving crimes, they are recovering property that has been missing for years. As the economy has worsened, the number of cattle and property thefts has gone up tremendously as unscrupulous people try to make a quick buck off the backs of hardworking citizens. So

many farmers and business owners have been hurt by these thieves. I am proud of what we have been able to accomplish by working together with other law enforcement agencies to solve crimes in Alabama."

The recovery of eighteen head of cattle at the Montgomery Stockyard was especially significant as it was the first investigation in Alabama where DNA testing was used to identify stolen

cattle. State Veterinarian Dr. Tony Frazier collected samples from the cattle and sent them to the State Diagnostic Lab in Auburn. From there, the samples were forwarded to a national laboratory to be compared with the DNA from samples collected from the suspected farm of origin. Five of the eighteen were positively identified by this DNA comparison to their farm.

Arrests have been made as a result of this undercover operation in Macon, Montgomery, Lowndes, Russell and Butler Counties and numerous others are pending in various counties. Property is being returned to the

rightful owners as items are identified.

The Department of Agriculture & Industries has been working closely with other state and local law enforcement agencies for many months.

## Alabama Meat Goat & Sheep Producers To Hold Referendum

Alabama goat and sheep producers will go to the polls Tuesday, May 12, to decide whether the Alabama Sheep & Goat Checkoff program should be continued for 5 more years at the current collection rate of 50¢ per head of sheep or goat sold in the state.



Any producer of goat and/or sheep in the state is eligible to cast a vote, but must vote in person at a polling place. The office of the Alabama Cooperative Extension System (ACES) in each county has been established as the official polling location for the referendum. Producers will be able to vote between 8 a.m. and the close of business at their county ACES office.

Program funds are collected by the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries, which remits the funds quarterly to the Alabama Meat Goat & Sheep Producers, a division of the Alabama Farmers Federation. A producer committee representing Alabama Meat Goat & Sheep Producers members from across the state determines how the funds are distributed.

The first Alabama Sheep & Goat Checkoff Program passed in January 2004. Alabama law requires a statewide producer referendum to be held every 5 years on whether the program should be continued. If approved, funds would be utilized to promote education, market development, research, youth livestock shows and other areas to further the state's sheep and goat industries.

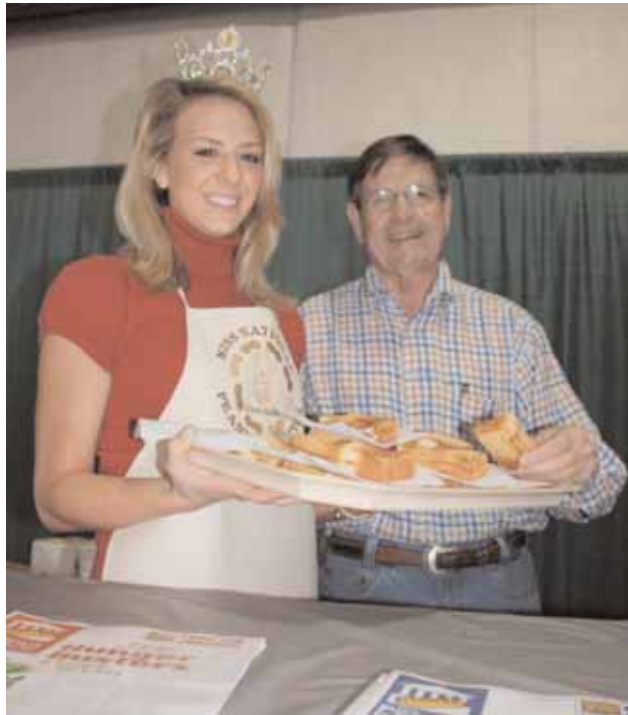
