CONTROL OF FERTILIZER AND FERTILIZER MATERIAL IN ALABAMA

The fertilizer control program in Alabama established by the Alabama Fertilizer Law of 1969, which is designated to protect manufacturers and users of fertilizer by the licensing of manufacturers and inspection, sampling and analysis of commercial fertilizer and fertilizer materials marketed in this state.

The fertilizer laws and the regulations promulgated by the State Board of Agriculture. The enforcement of the laws is administered by the Agricultural Compliance Inspection Division. The offices are in the Richard Beard Building, 1445 Federal Drive, Montgomery, Alabama 36107. The State Chemical Laboratory, Auburn, Alabama, carries out the analytical and laboratory work on all samples for fertilizer, lime, and feed.

COMMERCIAL VALUE OF FERTILIZERS

In keeping with Section §2-22-14 of the Alabama Fertilizer Law of 1969 (Chapter 22, Title 2, Code of Alabama 1975), it has been determined that the commercial values of the fertilizer ingredients, Nitrogen, P₂O₅, K₂O, were moved throughout the 2023-2024 year to be as follows:

- Nitrogen (N):
Beginning the year at \$16.91, and ending the year with \$12.45 per percent unit per ton
- Available Phosphorus (P₂O₅):
Beginning the year at \$11.04, and ending the year with \$13.27 per percent unit per ton
- Soluble Potassium (K₂O):
Beginning the year at \$10.70, and ending the year with \$9.20 per percent unit per ton

To compute the values of fertilizer according to this scale the valuation of nitrogen per ton obtained by multiplying the percent of this constituent by \$16.91. The value of available phosphorus per ton is determined by multiplying the percent of the constituent by \$11.04. The value of available soluble potassium is determined by multiplying the percent of soluble potassium by \$10.703 in order to arrive at the potash value per ton.

- An example of determining the commercial value of §4-12-12 is stated below:

Nitrogen (N) -----	4.00 x \$ 16.91 =	\$67.64
Available Phosphorus (P ₂ O ₅) -----	12.00 x \$ 11.04 =	\$132.42
Soluble Potassium (K ₂ O) -----	12.00 x \$ 10.70 =	\$128.40
