Thanks for being a part of my adventures in Alabama agriculture!


I am Alexander the rabbit and I want you to join me on my journey to learn more about Alabama's agricultural industry.

It's fun to farm in Alabama!



My name is Farmer John. Welcome to my farm, Alexander. Did you know many different products are grown in Alabama?








Alexander wants to fill his basket with a healthy variety of fruits and vegetables. Help him collect them and then find his way to the basket at the end of the maze.




Many Alabama farmers grow products that are not food. Some Alabama crops become clothes we wear.
