

# Seed & Propagule Acquisition Request

It is the grower's responsibility to identify a hemp seed or propagule source and select varieties suitable for cultivation in Alabama. Once a source and variety have been selected, the grower must submit a Seed & Propagule Acquisition Request containing the information listed below.

## Required Information

The following details must be included in your acquisition request:

- **Source Name**
- **Variety Name(s)**
- **Source Contact Information**  
(business name, mailing address, phone number, and email)
- **Sales Contact**  
(first and last name)
- **Quantity Intended**
- **Ordering and Receiving Information**  
  
(after getting approval)

## Important Notes

- Seed dealers **may not substitute** varieties or quantities listed on an approved request.
- **Seed purchases may only be made after receiving written approval from ADAI.**
- Each seed source must hold a current Alabama Seed Dealer Permit.
- Once the grower submits an acquisition request, ADAI will contact the listed source within two (2) business days.
- After ADAI receives the original Certificate(s) of Analysis (COA) from the source, the grower will receive an **email authorization to proceed with the purchase.**

## Approved Seed Sources

ADAI may provide growers with a list of seed sources that were approved during the previous licensed year. Please note that **ADAI does not endorse or promote any specific seed company, source, or sales representative.** The list is provided solely as a reference of previously approved sources.
