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New Product Registration in Alabama

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What requires a new product registration in Alabama?

Alabama registers pesticide products according to each unique label.

A new registration is required for:

- **A new pesticide product** being registered in Alabama for the first time.
- **A change to the product name** or other changes to the original registered product/label that affects the product identity.
- **A change in company name or ownership**, including changes involving an LLC, LTD, INC., etc.
- **Any change to the formulation**, including changes to active ingredients, Inert ingredients, other formulation components.
- **A change in signal word/toxicity class.**
- **A change from Restricted Use to General Use, or vice versa.**
- **A new alternate brand name (ABN).** Alabama requires each primary and alternate brand name to be registered separately.
- **Product Modes of Application**, for example, Concentrates, Ready to Spray, Ready to Use, Wands, Automatic Sprayers, Etc.
- **Products labels geared to unique user groups**, such as professional use only or by certified operators only.
- **Product labels with the same EPA registration number that differ in any manner where the product label is unique.** This would include specialty crop labels, directions of use, specific site labels, specific crop labels.
- **Certain packaging/combination configurations**, including kits, packs, multipacks, value packs, twin packs, combo/combination packs, pallets, cube packs, season packs, etc.
- **A new combination of a pesticide with a non-pesticide component** packaged and sold together can constitute a new, separate product under Alabama's current multipack policy.
- **Different colors, fragrances/scents, or animal-weight ranges** require separate registrations.
