To Produce certified sweet potato products, each producer must apply for certification annually with this department. This certification will be in accordance with the provisions of chapter 80-10-2, code of Alabama (1975). To be properly certified, each producer must complete an application for certification annually and adhere to the rules and regulations found in chapter 80-10-2, code of Alabama (1975). Please return this application, along with with your check or money order for the \$100.00 certification fee and the \$5.00 per acre inspection fee no later than May 15th of this year. Submission after this date must include a 15% penalty fee applied to the whole amount. (an additional \$15.00 for the certification fee and \$0.75 per acre for the inspection) Make checks or money orders payable to the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries (ADAI) and return with this application to the address above.

Please note that storage, plant bed, and field inspections, which are necessary to complete the certification process, will not be conducted unless we receive your completed application and fees. In addition, sweet Potato tags must be used for all sweet potato products sold but cannot be purchased until all fees are paid for the certification year and inspections completed.

Please list all sweet potato varieties you are requesting certification for, only these varieties will be certified.
