To produce certified sweet potato products, in accordance with chapter 80-10-2, code of Alabama (1975), you must apply for certification prior to planting but no later than May 15th of the certificate year. You are required to pay a \$100 registration fee and \$5 per acre inspection fee. Applications received after May 15th must include a 15% late fee applied to the entire amount.

Please note that storage, plant bed and field inspections, which are necessary to complete the certification process, will not be conducted until we receive your completed application and all fees prior to when those inspections should be performed. In addition, sweet potato tags must be used for all sweet potato products sold. They are available from this office for \$10 for a pack of 500 tags, plus any mailing or shipping charges.
