Enclosed is information relative to the Century and Heritage Farm Program .

The following is a summary of the ownership of the 262 acres of land currently owned by W.F. Cook Jr.

(Bill) and his wife Marsha E. Cook located in Wilcox County Alabama near Camden in the community of

Possum Bend. This property is part of the land purchased by Daniel Cook Sr., my Great Great

Grandfather in 1831 from the Land Office at Cahaba, Alabama's first Capitol.

Many of the facts and records of the history of the Cook family and the land they owned and farmed are documented in a book titled "The Book Of Cooks" written in 1978 by my Aunt Virginia Cook and Cousin Leacy Newell.

My farm is part of the land purchased by Daniel Cook Sr. as part of Land Patent No. 10030 on Nov. 14, 1831 from the Land Office at Cahaba. Our family still has several of the original land patent documents which were discovered by my father in an old trunk in the barn at Cook Hill next to the old homeplace.

When Daniel Cook Sr. died in 1878, part of his land and his home at Cook Hill, which he built from 1830-1839, were later inherited in 1899 by his son Daniel Cook Jr. who was my Great Grandfather.

Daniel Cook Jr., known to all the family as Papa, died in 1930 and his son Abe Crum Cook Sr., my Grandfather, inherited the Cook Hill Homeplace and surrounding 1,000 acre farm.

My Grandfather, Abe Cook Sr., died in 1958 and his widow, my Grandmother, Lallie Bragg Cook, died in 1973 which is the year that the property was divided among the four sons. My Father, Willis Floyd Cook Sr. inherited 226 acres of the original Daniel Cook property at this time.

My Father deeded me the 226 acres of land in 1991 and he died the next year in 1992. I was fortunate to be able to purchase an adjoining 36 more acres of the original Daniel Cook land in 2006 from Marion Cook Soderberg, my first cousin. All of the 1,000 acres of property owned by my Grandfather is still owned by different Cook first cousins of mine. Also the beautiful Cook Hill Homeplace built in 1830-39 is kept in immaculate condition by my first cousin, Sara Cook Blackwell, and her family.

I feel so blessed to be able to own some of the very farmland that my ancestors since 1830 have worked so hard to purchase, maintain and farm over the past 184 years and my full intentions are to never let it leave our family in the generations to come.




COOK HILL BARNS BUILT By DANIEL COOK 1800'S
